



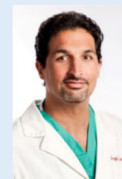

International Aortic Summit IAS2021

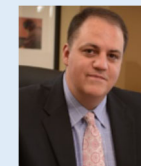

All rates are subject to service, government AHATA and Aruba Environmental Impact Levy. Current government tax rate is 9.5%, plus a \$3.00 per day environmental levy. The service charge is 15%. Portage is \$5.00 per person (which covers check-in and check-out).

TRAVEL INFORMATION

All visitors must have a passport for all travel to and from Aruba. We strongly encourage all U.S. citizen travelers to apply for a U.S. passport or passport card well in advance of anticipated travel. U.S. citizens can call 1-877-4USA-PPT (1-877-487-2778) for information on how to apply for their passports. Visiting this beautiful island is easy. Travel to Aruba from the U.S., Canada, South America, Europe, and the Caribbean is possible via most major carriers, either non-stop or with convenient connections. When entering the country, a current **passport is required of all passengers**. American, Canadian and EU citizens do not require visas, nor do most South Americans (e.g. Colombians and Venezuelans).

You are required to have an onward/return ticket, proof of enough funds and proof of lodging accommodations for your stay. The typical length of stay granted by immigration to U.S. citizens is 30 days and may be extended to 180 days by the office of immigration.
